I left Honeywell in 1956, so I lost track of Bob, but I will never forget him.

ing false and fraudulent workers' compensation claims and filing false tax returns. At its peak, Premier Medical owned and operated five clinics in the greater Los Angeles area and contracted with more than 100 medical providers. More than \$60 million in liens and bills created by Premier Medical Management Systems Inc. were pending before the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board (WCAB) and as part of the negotiated disposition, Fish and Bacino agreed to drop those claims.

*"Getting kickbacks for referring medical payments is illegal and drives up the costs in the system,"* Commissioner Poizner said. *"Because of our work and that of the Los Angeles District Attorney's office, we were able to prevent \$60 million in fraudulent and unnecessary claims in being made. We will continue to work hard to eliminate these unneeded costs to keep workers' compensation insurance affordable."*

CDI investigators reviewed more than 100,000 financial records in tracing the flow of money.

The investigation found that when a referral was received for a prospective workers' compensation case, the client was sent to doctors and other health care providers that had a business

relationship with Premier. Premier would do the billing and collection work in return for a 50 percent or more fee of what they collected. More than 16,000 patient referrals were purchased through the attorney advertising service.

As part of the negotiated plea, CDI received \$900,000 as reimbursement for investigative costs.
