



No More Budgeting Gimmicks; Time for Real Reform

Last week the Governor vetoed a budgeting gimmick recently pushed by liberals in the Legislature that would have abolished a voter-backed initiative to protect funding for our highways and roads. Considering that I was a strong 'NO' vote, I applaud the governor's choice.

Proposition 42, passed by voters in 2002, provides a specific formula for the allocation of sales tax revenue from gasoline purchases. Regrettably, the majority party schemed up a complex gas-tax swap that altered the sales tax

and increased the excise tax on gasoline by over 17 cents per gallon. Their complex maneuvering would've allowed bureaucrats to more easily rearrange where the gasoline revenues go, without a vote of the Legislature or the protection in funding associated with Proposition 42.

It's time to stop with the complicated gimmicks that ignore the wishes of the taxpayers, and start auditing spending and evaluating government programs for effectiveness. That's the only way we can find real savings in California.

Marcos City Council heard arguments from The Jumping Turtle Restaurant and Grill. The arguments and battle lines were fairly clearly drawn.

The city claims the restaurant/grill has consistently violated code restrictions and its entertainment permit restrictions, including vandalism, having under 21 patrons when alcohol was being served and a band was playing, and charging a cover fee. The Jumping Turtle owners, Matt Hall and Laura Moradian, through their attorney, Everett DeLano, denies many of the allegations and claims harassment, exaggerated claims, and a concerted effort to shut the venue down.

Tuesday's hearing was the final step in the appeals process. The Jumping Turtle's problems were compounded when, on February 9th, the city revoked the entertainment license following a brawl that involved two stabbings and a woman being hit in the face with a bottle.

Hall and his partner have filed two lawsuits against San Marcos and one against the San Diego County Sheriff's Department as yet another element in the dispute.

Controversial La Posada Project Nears Funding

The existing La Posada de Guadalupe homeless shelter will be expanded if almost \$2 million in funding is granted. The funds are part of an agricultural mitigation fund generated by fees paid by developers when they convert farmlands into residential or commercial properties.

The present property houses a number of trailers in which homeless people live which will be replaced by several buildings if and when the funds will be granted.

Critics have complained that the \$2 million is being allocated to homeless people and migrant farm workers, many of whom may be illegal immigrants and, as such, the government is condoning lawbreakers not only living in the area but being subsidized by the American taxpayer.

The property has been shepherded through the city by Catholic Charities - who proposes to build a 50 bed shelter on the property. The total project cost is projected at \$3.5 million.

Oceanside Trash Deal Awaits Closure

Waste Management Inc., of North County offered \$83,000 a month to the city of Oceanside as part of the nego-

tiations for a new three-year contract but City Councilmembers could not agree on the terms and now they are blaming each other for the financial loss to the city that could run nearly \$1 million.

It is likely the current contract will be extended by one year if no agreement is reached by June 30th, the contract deadline.

Councilmembers Jerry Kern and Jack Feller say the city should have taken the deal and the money, while Mayor Jim Wood and Councilmember Esther Sanchez say Feller and Kern should join them in requiring the contract holder to sweeten the deal. Meantime, no headway has been made and contract negotiations are at a standstill.

One option is to put the contract out for bid to see if other waste management firms can make a better bid.

Waste Management, Inc., had offered to pay the city \$1 million a year in monthly installments that would begin as soon as the council extended the contract by three years.

The council is deadlocked because Rocky Chavez, its fifth member, accepted an appointment by Governor Schwarzenegger to become state secretary of veteran affairs.
