When compared to other states, California's support of the technology industry has become virtually non-existent.

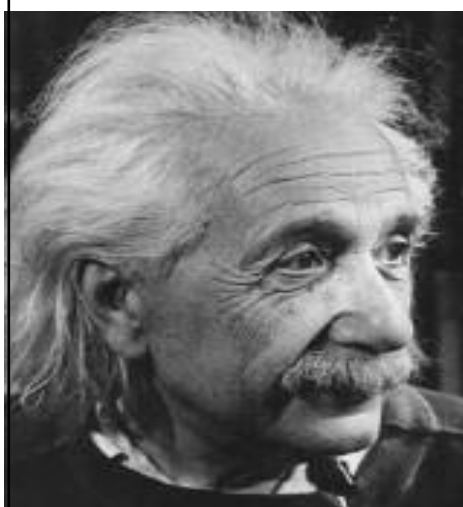
