A whole new level of procrastination occurred last week when the Democrats were exposed for going on a statewide "road

show" in an attempt to sell their ideas to Californians, instead of working on a budget deal in Sacramento. Legislators spared no expense on their taxpayer-funded trip, including \$535 to rent and transport video equipment to an auditorium that was seven miles away from the Capitol and an employee enjoying a \$35 taxi instead of a \$2 bus.

Democrats must stop wasting time, and instead come back to the negotiation table with real ideas to close the \$19 billion budget gap. To me, there's no more crucial issue to address.



Budget One Month Late, Time for Democrats to Step Up to the Plate

The state budget is now more than one month late. Meanwhile, California still faces a \$19.1 billion dollar budget deficit, and overspends by \$52 million dollars per day.

The longer it takes to pass a budget, the deeper the reductions need to be, and the more painful the choices become. Just this week, the Governor announced that he is reinstating furloughs in order to preserve cash.

The fact is we simply can't afford to keep spending at this rate any longer. And yet, after months of negotia-

tions, legislative Democrats still don't have any plans to bridge the total budget gap.

Back in May, Republicans united behind a responsible budget plan to: set priorities, preserve last year's funding levels for education, and significantly reduce overspending. Democrats said "no." And nearly 80 days later, they still haven't come up with any credible counter-proposal.

Instead of reducing overspending, they are counting on: federal dollars, internal fund shifts, and rosy economic projections to paper over half the deficit. They would rely on billions of dollars in tax increases and illegal borrowing to make up the other half.

It's time for Democrats to step up to the plate with a credible plan to close the \$19.1 billion dollar deficit.

D'Agosta Calls for Term Limits in Escondido

Former Escondido City Council Member and current Mayoral candidate Tom D'Agosta is calling for Escondido's Council Members to be subject to eight years in office. He argues that to do otherwise merely perpetuates an individual in office and he or she becomes 'stagnant,' gets too involved with special interest groups, and tends to vote in their favor rather than what is good for the community.

"Hogwash," says Mayor Pro-Tem Dick Daniels. "Challengers have defeated incumbents several times. Tom is well aware of this as he lost to a challenger, Sam Abed, when Tom was an incumbent. Ed Gallo lost to a challenger, Olga Diaz, Ed was an incumbent."

D'Agosta served on the council from 2000 to 2004 before being narrowly defeated by Sam Abed.

He has at least one supporter on the current Council, Olga Diaz. If D'Agosta is elected mayor on Nov. 2, he and Diaz, would need one more vote among the five-member panel to place term limits on a future election ballot.

Without a third vote they would have the option of starting a petition drive that could also put term limits on the ballot, a petition drive that has already failed once in 2008 due to a lack of sufficient signatures.

State voters adopted term limits for governor, Senate and Assembly in 1990, and San Diego County voters approved term limits for the Board of Supervisors in June. The question is, would that same voter sentiment translate itself to city elections?

Abed said D'Agosta is using this a political ploy to break up the "pro-business" majority that has dominated the council for the last decade.

Daniels said term limits have been a failure in state politics and often deprive voters of quality representatives who possess crucial institutional knowledge.

Pfeiler and Waldron have said they both oppose term limits.

"Our voters are well-informed, so it should be their decision whether to keep people in office," said Abed. "When voters here are unhappy with an incumbent, they vote them out."

Diaz said the best argument for term limits is the need for new ideas and fresh perspective in City Hall.

lion loss for June and an \$18.5 million loss for the 2009-10 fiscal year. The district also said there are more than 17,000 unpaid debts dating to 2004, all of which have been recently sent to legal services. The district's cash reserves, officials say, are at \$75 million. Administrators recently announced the district would cut 93 positions, saving about \$6 million in wages and benefits. Tri-City CEO Larry Anderson said the district was making progress.

sands of lives and destroyed four square miles of downtown Johnstown. Upon her departure, the grateful citizens of the city gave Clara Barton a gold pin and locket, set in diamonds and amethysts, and the American Red Cross had forever proved its worth to the nation.

Lake Conemaugh no longer exists. The South Fork dam was never rebuilt. Built into a river valley, Johnstown suffered minor flooding several times after that dark year, but never again will any of its citizens suffer a catastrophe that once gripped the entire nation.
